## Who we are:

ICDI, a Dutch based NGO with offices in Leiden, is looking for an intern (Masters' student) during the academic year 2023/2024.

As a [knowledge organization](#) we develop meaningful, effective solutions so that all children, can grow up in safe, loving and nurturing environments and lead happy lives. We care for their social and emotional well-being and rights. We support children, families and communities to strengthen their relationships, and to jointly explore, learn and develop.

## Who You are:

- The intern will support ICDI staff in carrying out research and training activities in projects related to Early Childhood Development and Education, child protection and well-being, youth participation, gender equity and social inclusion in Europe, Africa, Southeast Asia and Central America. Most of the activities will happen remotely. Presence in the office in Leiden is requested once a week on Thursdays.
- We expect the intern(s) to be involved 2-3 days a week (16-24 hours) for a period of at least 6 months.

## In this position you will have an opportunity to:

- Designing monitoring and evaluation (M&E) frameworks and analysing M&E data
- Developing, revising, and updating Toolkits and Manuals
- Designing and delivering (with ICDI staff) training sessions on specific topics.
- Participating in project development including writing short literature reviews.

All interns will be supervised by ICDI staff with at least a Masters' Degree in Social Sciences (e.g., Cultural Anthropology, Child Psychology, Education, Social Policy and Public Health).
