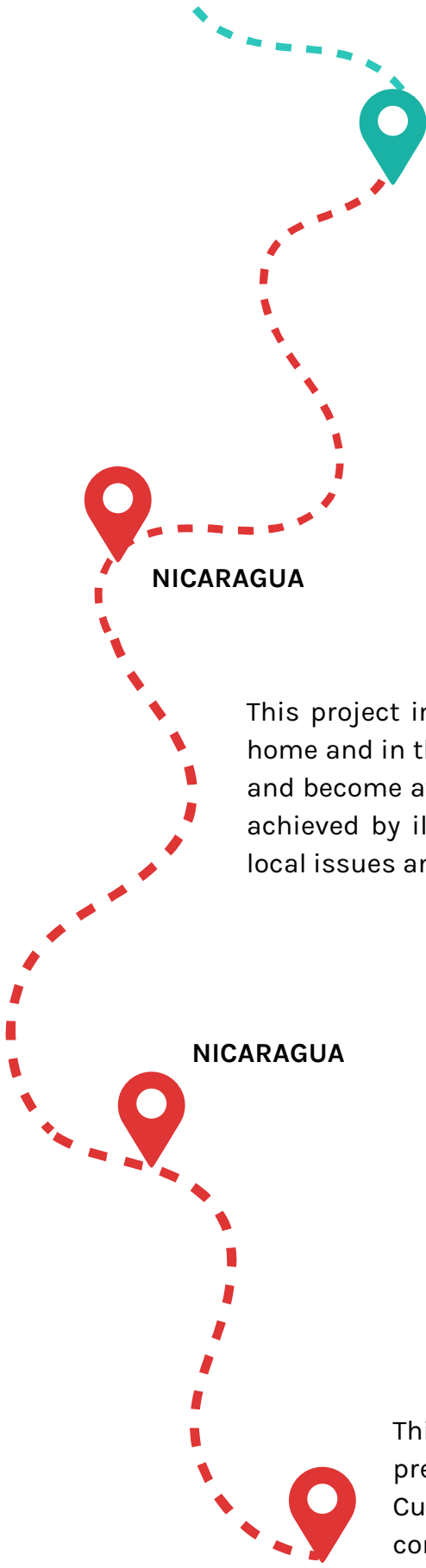


LATVIA

SUSTAINABLE STORYTELLING

This project intends to motivate children to practice sustainable habits at home and in the community, recognise the environmental issues in the area, and become aware that every decision impacts the environment. This will be achieved by illustrating an environmental story that allows to identify the local issues and propose various solutions within reach.

RESCUE OF OUR TRADITIONAL AND MEDICINAL PLANTS

NICARAGUA

Using native plants is a way to care for the Earth and the environment. The main activity of this project is to create a botanical garden in a primary school. This garden, will facilitate practical learning of the knowledge that children acquire in class. Children and adults will be empowered to trust the power of nature via the consumption of alternative natural medicines.

EXPAND OUR GARDEN TO ENSURE HEALTHY FOOD

NICARAGUA

This project aims to improve the nutrition of about 600 children from preschool to elementary school by expanding the school gardens. Currently, the fruits and vegetables grown in these gardens are a component of the student meals. This expansion will implement new organic care techniques to enhance production quality, including drip irrigation, pest control, and soil erosion prevention.
